







CAR CRICKET

Car Cricket is an Aussie favourite and a great way to keep your passengers occupied on a long trip. Using similar scoring to cricket, Car Cricket is much more fast passed and exciting. Car Cricket is best played on long stretches of road and double lane highways, not busy freeways.

RULES:

1. One person bats at a time – scoring runs when a particular vehicle is spotted.
2. Cars must be traveling in the opposite direction to you to be counted as a run.
3. Stationary vehicles are not counted
4. Each type of vehicle and size are worth different runs
 - a. Sedan/ Hatchbacks = 1 run
 - b. Wagons/ 4WD/ UTES = 2 runs
 - c. Motorbikes = 3 runs
 - d. Bus/ Van/ Small Trucks = 4 runs
 - e. Big Trucks = 6 runs
 - f. Vehicles Towing = 1 Run “overthrow”
 - g. Red Vehicles = OUT
5. Each passenger takes a turn adding up as many runs as they can before they go out or before they make 100 runs and retire
6. The player with the most runs after everyone has had a turn is the Winner!
7. The game can be played until a player reaches 100.
8. The rules are very flexible and it’s lots of fun especially when everyone gets involved looking ahead for red cars.
